

## Indonesian Alliance Commences Cement Exports to the U.S.

Taiheiyo Cement Corporation (Headquarters: Bunkyo-ku, Tokyo; President and Representative Director: Yoshifumi Taura) announces that SBI<sup>\*1</sup>, an Indonesian company in which we hold an equity stake, has commenced cement export to our U.S. subsidiary.



SBI's Tuban Plant: Export Jetty and Cement Carrier

In 2021, we entered into a capital and business alliance agreement with SIG<sup>\*2</sup>, a state-owned cement company in Indonesia, and its group company SBI. The aim of the alliance was for Taiheiyo Cement to establish a business foundation in Indonesia and support trading operations in partnership with SBI for exports to the U.S. The agreement provided for significant capital investment, including the construction of a loading jetty and silos at SBI's Tuban plant to support the export of cement to our U.S. subsidiary.

Following the completion of facilities, SBI has commenced exports with the first shipment to our U.S. subsidiary on 1 June 2026. To celebrate this milestone, a ceremony was held at SBI's Tuban plant on 11 June, attended by representatives from SIG, SBI, Taiheiyo Cement and other stakeholders. This achievement not only contributes to SBI's business performance but also secures a stable supply source of over 500,000 tons per year for our U.S. operations, further deepening partnership between the two companies.

With demand in the U.S. market expected to continue growing, the addition of this new shipping base will further strengthen our group's extensive network across the Pacific Rim, and we anticipate that this will further enhance our competitiveness in the US market. Furthermore, as demand for low-carbon cement has been growing in the U.S. in recent years, we will explore the possibility of manufacturing blended cement to meet local needs in collaboration with SBI, leveraging the company's advanced manufacturing technology.

We will continue to strengthen our business foundation in Southeast Asia, whilst contributing to the development of social infrastructure and a circular economy through the supply of cement and other products that meet local needs, with the aim of sustainable growth.
